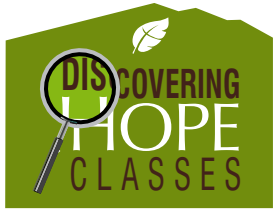

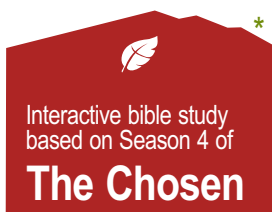
The Story of Reality
