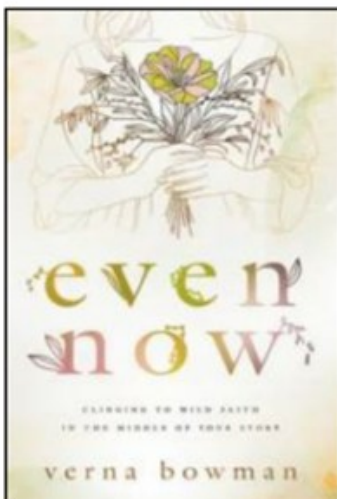
## Our Speaker
