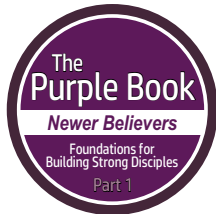
Gro Groups gather to study the word of God directly (or as a primary resource) to cultivate spiritual health and growth.
